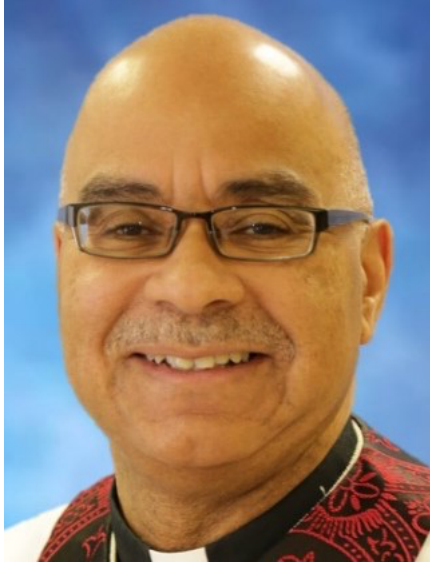


Pastor Robert C. Rogers
